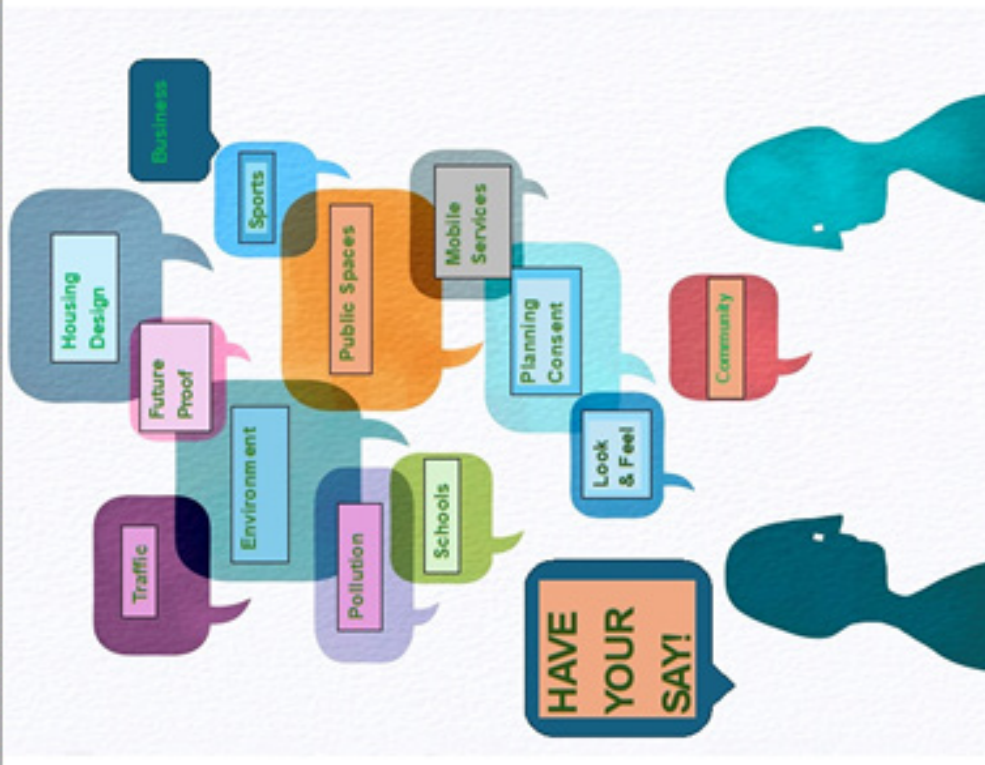

People and Place Plan Questionnaire

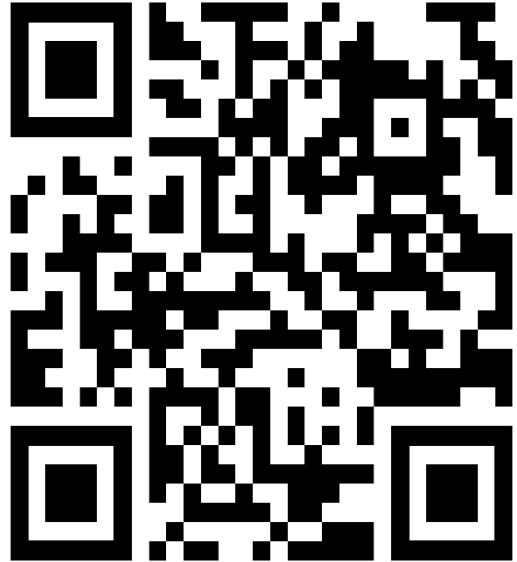
This questionnaire has been developed to capture the views of the Hintlesham and Chattisham communities about how our Parish areas should develop over the next 10 years.

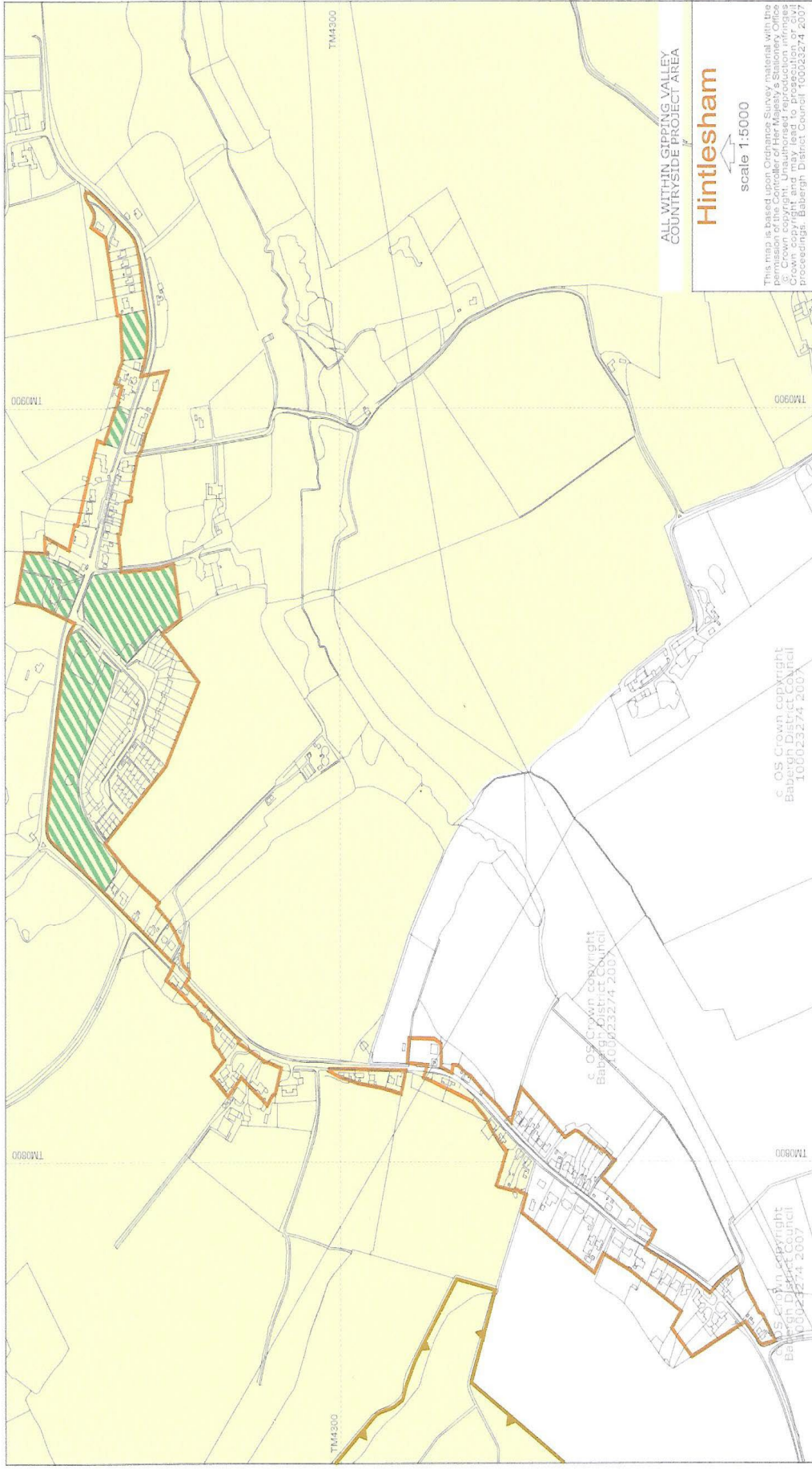

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D. Village Boundaries

There are currently Settlement Boundaries defined by Babergh Council for Hintlesham and Chattisham, outside of which new development is unlikely to be approved. This boundary was set in 2007 and is likely to be revised in Autumn 2024 for the next 10 years. It is very important that we have a view on this issue.

Approximately 5km south-west of Ipswich, Chattisham is classified as a Hamlet. There is a cluster of listed buildings surrounding the Grade II* listed Church of All Saints to the east of the settlement.

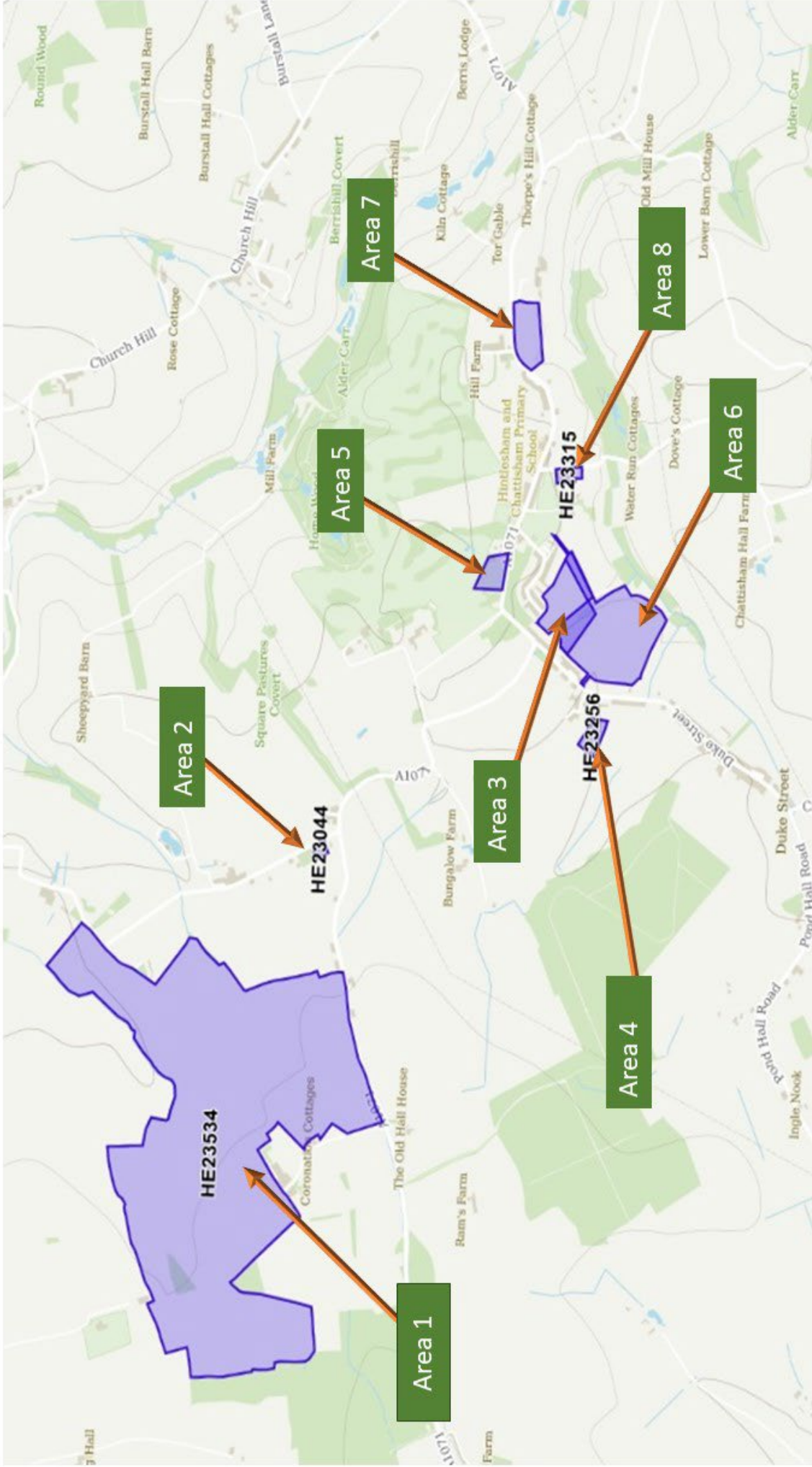
