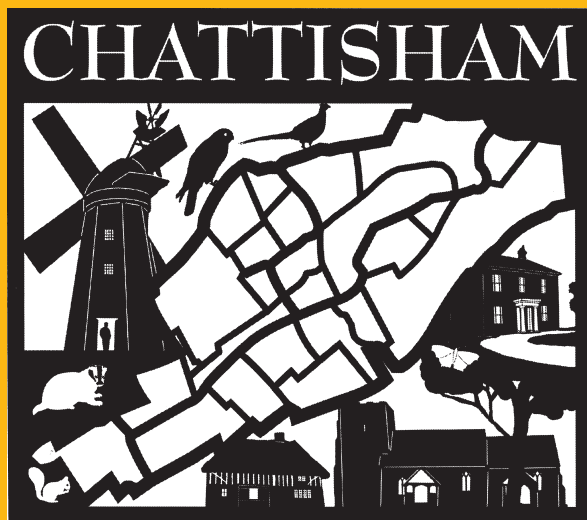

Parish Councillors are elected every fourth year by those on the local electoral roll and each year the Councillors elect a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Committee.

The Parish Council meets at 7.30p.m. at the Community Hall, on the second Thursday of the month (not August) – see notices in the parish magazine 'Village Link' and on notice boards around the villages.

The Parish Council also meets on the 4th Thursday of the month to discuss any Planning Applications where comments have to be back to Babergh D.C. before the following Parish Council Meeting. ALL Meetings are open to the public. At the Annual Parish Meeting (April) electors hear reports on the activities of the Council and other local organisations and can have their say on local matters. The Parish Council takes responsibility for many matters affecting the village. It can also use its 'village rate' to provide grants and other facilities for village organisations. **(Applications for grants should be sent to the Treasurer by 31st November – up to date accounts must be included).**

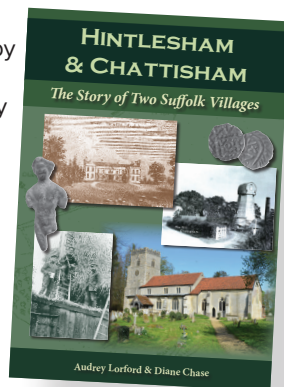
